YMCA Decreases Child Care Locations

Chatham, ON – The YMCA of Chatham-Kent will be closing their full day child care programs at St. Joseph School and Gregory Drive locations and the Full Day and Before-And-After school programs at St. Vincent School in Chatham effective June 26, 2009.

Due to low enrolment, the YMCA can no longer sustain these programs. The YMCA of Chatham-Kent will continue to provide full day care at both the YMCA King Street and at Our Little Place on Cecile Street and the Before-And-After school programs at five locations in Chatham-Kent.

The YMCA of Chatham-Kent remains committed to the Best Start Child Care program and will continue operations at Our Lady of Fatima School. YMCA staff at the affected locations will be offered employment opportunities within the YMCA.

The YMCA is a charitable organization dedicated to serving our community through the development of all people in spirit, mind and body. The YMCA reaches out to children and families throughout the community to provide opportunities that they might otherwise never have. Through programs and services, the YMCA provides the recreational, learning and life enriching experiences that build strong kids, strong families and strong communities.
